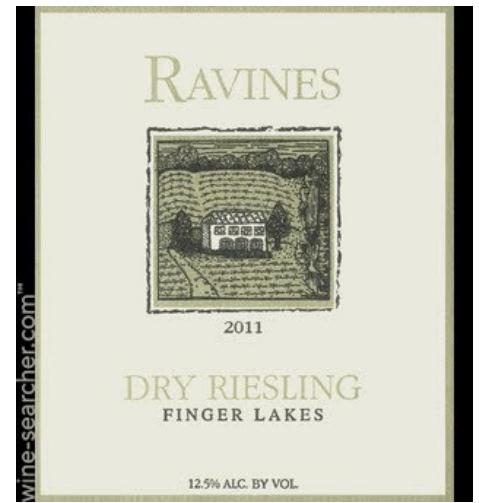


Ravines Dry Riesling 2011



Winemaker's Notes

Dry Riesling produced from a single vineyard, the Argetsinger Vineyard on Seneca Lake, one of the oldest Riesling vineyards in the Finger Lakes. The Argetsinger Vineyard's limestone soils produce a grape of lean minerality and complex floral aromatics.

All of the Riesling grapes for this single vineyard wine come from the Argetsinger Vineyard on the east side of Seneca Lake in the town of Hector. This vineyard is an exceptionally well drained site where the 198 Riesling clone was field grafted onto old existing vines, making it one of the oldest Riesling vineyards in all of the Finger Lakes. The soil is Howard Gravel over limestone bedrock.
