We don't have a terrific amount of information about the folks at Villa Aix. We know there is a large, luxury, Provence-inspired home there. We know the vines are around 25 years old and are Cabernet Sauvignon planted by Philippe Langner. And we know this is the first vintage they have bottled under their own name. Neighbors include Lancaster Estate and Chalk Hill. The estate isn't far from the Russian River or Healdsburg. Production is on the small side and its highly unlikely that it will ever get ranked or scored by anybody. Such is the life of the small winery.

What we do know is that the wine is good.
