

PARR TROKEN REISLING

- 10.5% alcohol with laser-sharp acidity from an AVA in Santa Barbara, known most for Chardonnay.

Nose: mineral slate, with sour green apples + savory sage butter.

Palate: herbal start followed by subtle oak and creaminess, which distinguishes this wine from German Riesling.

- No contrasting sweetness to the acidity of the green fruits.
- Its simplicity meant that it was great with devilled crab and toast.
