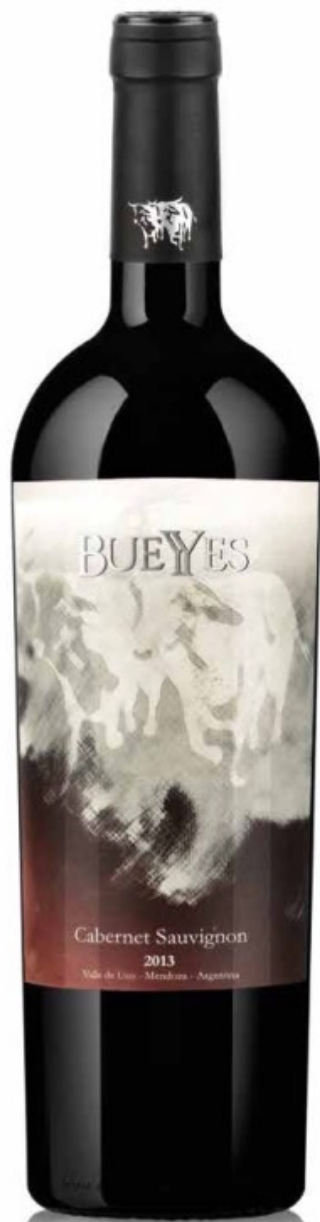

### WINEMAKER

### VINEYARD

La Consulta, Uco Valley, Argentina  
11 year old vines (organically farmed)

### YIELD

3.6 tons per acre (8.8 tons per hectare)

### HARVEST

By hand last week of April in 18kg bins

### FERMENTATION

Pre-fermentation maceration for 5 days; fermentation in stainless steel tanks for 10-15 days. Malolactic fermentation in barrels.

### BARREL AGING

8 months in 40% French and 60% American barrels (35% new)

### ALCOHOL

14.4%

### PRODUCTION

833 cases of 12
