Wine description

Yellow, straw-coloured, with a shade of gold. A complex bouquet, with a fragrant hint of ripe citrus, dried fruit, cedar, buttered toast. Its softness and warmth are pleasantly combined with the chewy structure of a red wine. A long-lasting aftertaste. Very drinkable. A very mineral wine.

With food

Meat or soup as starters; main dishes with truffles; grilled fish; poultry; and cooked meats.

Aging

Suitable for drinking, with an excellent ageing potential, at least ten years.

- Grape type ribolla
- Region Brda - Slovenia
- Vineyards Medana, Breg
- Vineyards age 55-62 years
- Vineyards altitude 200-250 metres above sea level
- Vineyards exposure north-west
- Soil type marl, slate and sandstone (opoka)
- Harvest hand-harvested, bunches carefully selected, beginning of October
- Vinification fermentation in contact with skins of berries (maceration) in 3,000l conical oak barrels (tino); the selected yeast is not augmented; after 6 months the wine is separated from grape skins
- Maturation 18 months in 500l oak barrels (tono)
- Maturing in Bottle at least 6 months
- Alcohol 13,5% vol
- Total acidity 5,1 g/l
- Bottle 0,75 l
- Bottling 1.500 bottles in August 2014
- Serving temperature 15°C
