Winemaker:

Our Winemaker, Greg Bjornstad, believes that care taken in the vineyard creates a beautiful wine in the bottle. His hands-on approach during the growing season is balanced by a philosophy of allowing the true characteristics of the terroir to express themselves with minimal intervention during winemaking.

Winemaker Notes:

Bright ruby in color with black cherry, blackberry liqueur, violets and spice. The bright middle is dominated by black raspberry, rhubarb, chocolate orange, minerals, tobacco leaf, dusty tannins and well-mannered acidity that keep it all in balance.

Technicals:

Brix at Harvest: 25° brix

Harvest Dates: October 11th -19th, 2014

Varietal: 100% Pinot Noir

Alcohol: 14.2%

Winemaking: 7-10 day cold soak, then warm-up and

inoculated for primary. Basket press within a week and primary finishes in barrel within two weeks. Some barrel

stirring and all native secondary

fermentations are finished by December.

Cooperage: 11 months French oak (50% new)
Clones: Joseph Swan, Calera & Pommard
