Bourassa Vineyard is located in south Napa in a business center same center near the Jameson Canyon pass. Vic Bourassa is the owner and winemaker, and was encouraged in his winemaking after a 1999 meeting with Robert Mondavi when they shared some Bourassa Pinot Noir.



Bourassa devotes much of their attention to the five Bordeaux varietals: Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec, Merlot, and Petit Verdot. Current production is 3,500 cases from grapes that are sourced from Napa vineyards.

Bourassa's winemaking philosophy is simple: create something special, something that you would be proud to share with your friends. The wines, no matter what the varietal, are painstakingly hand-crafted in small lots. The winery carefully creates rich, complex blends using grapes from premiere, hand-tended Napa Valley vineyards as they showcase the terroir that has become so well known throughout the world



Tasting Notes:

Intense aromas of mixed berries, tobacco and dried herbs. It has an old world palate of wild berries and great balance and structure. Medium tannins contribute to a long mouthwatering finish. Best if opened an hour before serving.
