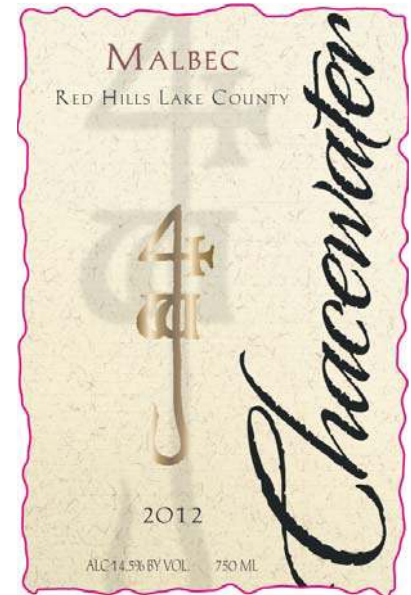


Chacewater

Tasting Notes

A very ripe and dense wine giving layers of fig, blueberry and currant. Spicy French oak core with ample toast and integrated with richness that emerges into a lengthy fresh finish.
