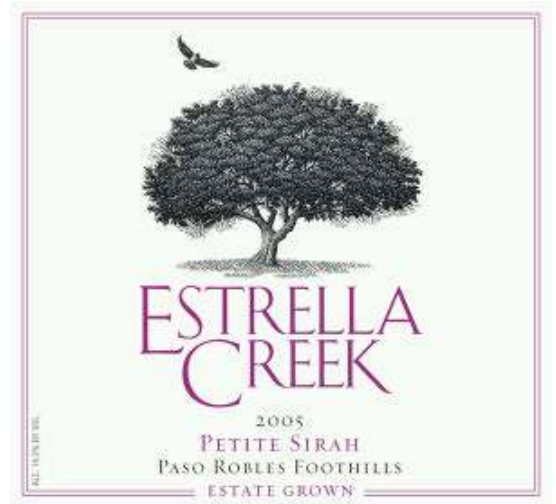


ESTRELLA CREEK WINES

2005 PETITE SIRAH



VARIETAL: 100% Estate Grown Petite Sirah
APPELLATION: Paso Robles, CA (Estrella area)
VINEYARD: 4M Vineyards
HARVEST DATE: November 16, 2005
BRIX AT HARVEST: 26.0
ALCOHOL: 14.8%
ACIDITY: 0.65g/100mL
PH: 3.67
DATE BOTTLED: December 7, 2007
CASES BOTTLED: 150

GROWING CONDITIONS: 2005 featured a normal bud break following a very moist winter. With a cool spring followed by a warm summer, and a later than normal harvest, the additional hang time produced smaller clusters with lush, concentrated fruit.

TASTING NOTES: A readily approachable, dark and inky Petite Sirah with blackberry and plum on the nose. Complementing flavors of boysenberry jam, clove spice and black pepper fill the mouth with a long, lingering finish.

WINEMAKING: All fruit was hand harvested. Must was pumped over twice daily for 12 days then sealed for 9 days of additional maceration prior to pressing. After fermentation, the wine was aged in American oak barrels for 22 months prior to bottling.
