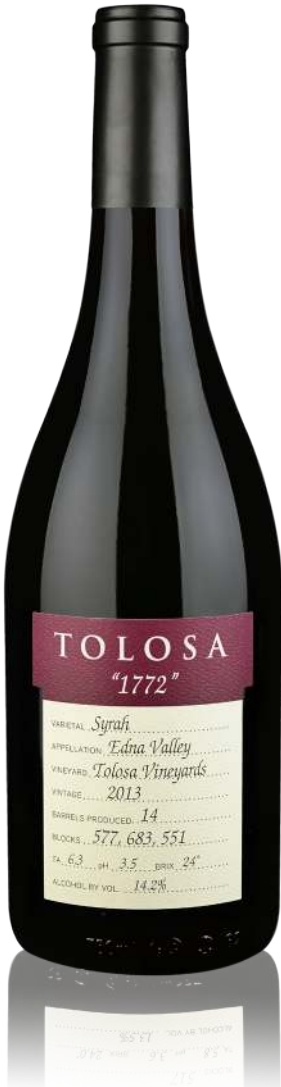




# TOLOSA 1772 SYRAH 2013

## WINEMAKER NOTES

The Syrah grapes for this wine were sourced from our Salaal and Hollister vineyards on our Edna Ranch and includes two clones. Clone 99, a late ripening French clone with big berries and sizable clusters and clone 877 which offers an impressive tannin profile. The wine was fermented in stainless steel tanks and aged for 20 months in small French and American oak barrels.

## TASTING NOTES

Deep ruby red color with the inviting aromas of toasted bread, malted chocolate, allspice and cigar box. Generous flavors of blackberry jam, black licorice and violets flood the palate while achieving a balance with the soft round tannins and full bodied mouthfeel. The rich fruit flavors of this wine would pair well with a pork tenderloin topped with a reduction sauce.
