



Domaine Capitain-Gagnerot Saint Romain 2013

- Producer:** Pierre-Francois Capitain, 8th generation producer of this estate since 1802.
- Site:** "Aus bas Poillange" above the village of Saint Romain (parcel in above photo)
- Grape:** Chardonnay
- Age:** 47 years
- Yield:** Strictly limited at 40hl/ha
- Soil:** White marls, with ancient seashells and limestone.

Vinification: No herbicides nor pesticides. Handpicked, avoiding unnecessary stems and leaves in the crush. Vinification of this white burgundy is 'traditional', meaning a cold maceration for 10 to 12 days, leading up to fermentation. The 'floating cap' is pumped over and punched down twice a day. Maceration is 'pelliculaire', meaning the grapes are macerated whole, allowing the 'pre-fermentation' to occur inside the grape skins. Oak aging with only 10% of the oak is new.

Tasting Notes

Clear gold hue with light green highlights. Expressive bouquet of lemon/lime with a floral bouquet of white orchids. Racy and opulent, with a mouthful of silky fruit salad of white peach, honey and minerals.'
