PDO Red Roanne Coast

GRAPE

Gamay Saint Romain

TERROIR

Granite (rhyolite), wine from a closed (1,7 hectares, altitude 515 meters) exposed East, enjoying a micro climate and an exceptional terroir

VENDANGES

Manual with sorting in the vineyard

VINIFICATION

3/4 destemmed, maceration of 18 days, igeages

BREEDING

11 months in barrels of 500 liters and tuns

POTENTIAL OF CUSTODY

Up to 10 years



TASTING NOTES:

The aromas that develop this wine at the tasting, are of the order of very ripe fruity notes such as the strawberry then the blackcurrant and draws thereafter on the spicy register; such as cinnamon and nutmeg. It will be a good match for a Charolais beef rib or pork cheek with honey and sage beer.
