Furthermore Rosella's Vineyard Pinot Noir

2014 Santa Lucia Highlands, California

Located east of Monterey Bay, this vineyard has foggy mornings, breezy afternoons and a long drawn out growing season. The vineyard is farmed by SLH legend Gary Franscioni, whose family has been farming the Salinas Valley for over one hundred years. This Pinot Noir is velvety raspberry palate with a hint of blood orange and alluring floral aromas. Pretty and precise, it is delicate for this rich-leaning region. Wild strawberry and rhubarb flavors pop on the sip, alongside watermelon rind and a very rocky and tense minerality. There is tons of tannic and acidic depth. 94 Points from Wine Enthusiast. **\$59.99/btl**

Kiamie R'Own Red Blend

2016 Adelaida District, Paso Robles, CA

65% Grenache, 23% Tannat, 9% Syrah

This Cote du Rhone inspired wine is dark and dense yet remains elegant and feminine, showing candied blackberry, crème de cassis and pressed mulberry aromas, accented by savory hints of grilled exotic spiced meats. Soft, yet lush and refined tannins engulf the palate, elongating with time, while boisterous acidity accentuates brambleberry, and crushed granite flavors.

Laurel Glen "Counterpoint" Cabernet Sauvignon

2015 Sonoma Mountain, California

This is an approachable release from the mountain estate that is known for ageworthy Cabernet. Earthy and herbal, it offers clove, cedar and peppery notes on the nose. The fruit is ripened to the point of fatness, juicy black plum and tart-sweet blackberry flavors tasting bright and fresh.
