J. Wilkes Pinot Blanc

2016 Santa Maria Valley, California

Pure and focused with tangerine flesh, peach skin, subtle white flowers / citrus blossom, saline, chalk, and granite great your nose. On the palate this wine is focused and nervy from the oldest Pinot Blanc vines (and a few Melon de Bourgogne) in California, with a touch more structure / acid / verve than previous vintages. Bright and dry with wonderful stone-fruit persistence, mouth-cleansing freshness. Fantastic either as a cocktail wine, Summer Sipper, wine for the lake or the ocean (boating), or with a wide variety of foods. \$17.99/btl

Nicola's Red Mark Pinot Grigio

2014 Columbia Valley, Washington

Made from 100% Pinot Gris grapes grown on the White Bluffs Estate Vineyards which is certified LIVE Sustainable and Salmon Safe. Fermentation with the skins gives this wine a medium body and light "orange" tint. Stone fruit and jasmine tea aromas transcend onto the palate which contains noticeable volume. The finish is crisp with sweet fruit extending on into the distance. **\$10.99/btl**

Walter Scott "La Combe Verte" Pinot Noir

2017 Willamette Valley, Oregon **New Arrival!**

A classic Willamette Valley Pinot noir in all the right ways, with a bounty of bright and dark fruits, orange-y goodness and Earl Grey tea. At once juicy and surprisingly powerful in its structure, here's your window into 2017 -- you're going to love the view. A blend of Justice, Sojourner, Freedom Hill, Clos des Oiseaux, and Prophet vineyards. **\$34.99/btl**

Alchemy Carmenere Cachapoal Valley 2014

Lots of ripe fruit with tar and blueberry character. Medium to full body with a juicy finish. Cool interpretation of carmenere, a grape that was initially thought to be Merlot and harvested too early thus producing terrible wines. This has since been corrected due to DNA testing, correctly identifying the grape, and thus harvesting at appropriate times. – 92 Points- James Suckling **\$25.99/btl**

Chateau Des Combes Rouge

2015 Bordeaux, France (63% Merlot, 37% Cabernet Sauvignon)

This lovely Bordeaux offers pleasant red-fruit, vanilla and spice aromas. It is supple and fruity with structure, soft tannins and some length on the finish Pairs nicely with tapas, red meat, white meat, cheeses. At this price, you really can't go wrong! **\$16.99/btl**
