Graham Beck Brut

NV, Robertson South Africa (57% Pinot Noir, 43% Chardonnay)

Here's a balanced, accessible and attractive sparkler perfect for any occasion! It greets you with fresh aromas and flavors of green apple, orange peel and water crackers. The palate is framed by lively acidity and high carbonation. Vibrant and mouthwatering. **\$14.99/btl**

Toblar Pinot Grigio

2015 Friuli Isonzo DOC, Italy

A beautiful yellow color with copper reflections, this wine is intense and complex, with floral notes of wild roses and acacia. It is elegant and full with a balanced acidity. This is a great pre-dinner (or beach) drink but also pairs well with light appetizers. **\$19.99/btl**

Alchemy Grand Cuvee

2014 Cachapoal Valley, Chile (55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Carmenere, 10% Syrah, 5% Malbec)

This blend is made up of the best grapes from each plot. The beauty of the Alchemy wines is they do everything by hand in the process of harvesting and winemaking. After 24 months in French Oak barrels you are left with a wine that is full of soft round tannins with touches of vanilla and berries dancing over your tongue. **\$24.99/btl**

Arabella Pinotage

2013 Western Cape, South Africa

I bet the first question in your mind when you read the word Pinotage was "What the hell is a Pinotage?!". Well Pinotage is a grape variety that was created in South Africa in 1925 by Abraham Izak Perold, the first Professor of Viticulture at Stellenbosch University. It is a cross between Pinot Noir and Cinsault and is now known as South Africa's signature red grape! This one possesses inviting aromas redolent of mocha and chocolate. On the palate lovely fruity notes of bananas and blueberries dance on the front end while a nice spicy, smoky undertone rounds out the back end of the wine. A great value at only **\$14.99/btl**

Sean Minor Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon

2016 Napa Valley, California

Sophisticated and refined, Cabernet is always a dinner party favorite. Aromas of ripe blackberry, red and black currants. Flavors of blackberries and ripe plum fill the mid-palate, entwined with black currant, mocha and black pepper, providing for a full-bodied and rich wine experience. The soft tannins and sweet oak balance lead to a long and lingering finish. Pair it with a juicy rib eye! **\$24.99/btl**
