Terramossa No.1 Rosé Brut

NV, Carpineta di Cesena, Emilia-Romagna, Italy (100% Sangiovese)

Brut sparkling wine produced by Martinotti (charmot) method. The base of this rose is Sangiovese grapes from which you get a fresh, fruity, well-balanced wine. Hints of violet flowers and cherry, the lovely fruit and floral notes make it pleasant companion for starters and aperitif. **\$19.99/btl**

Stephan Ross Albariño *New Arrival!*

2016 Spanish Springs Vineyard, San Luis Obispo County, CA

This is a cool climate vineyard due to its close proximity to the Pacific Ocean at Pismo Beach on California's Central Coast. The wine was fermented cold in stainless steel on the lees giving it a bright acidity, stone fruit aromas and flavor that finishes with sunshine and ripe flavors. This wine is searching for a dozen oysters, Dover sole or asparagus risotto. An extra dimension is added with a whisper of fine tannins on the finish. **\$23.99/btl**

Cantina Tollo Terre di Chieti Rosso *New Arrival!*

2017 Abruzzo, Italy (Montepulciano, Merlot)

A medium bodied blend from the Tollo family vineyards which are cultivate organically. Delicate aromas of plum, cherry, violets and roses with hints of licorice. Soft tannins and a lengthy finish make this wine a good pairing with many types of dishes... perhaps for your next dinner at Fritto Misto? **\$17.99/btl**

MADE WITH ORGANIC GRAPES

Mariposa Red Blend *New Arrival!*

2016 Loncomilla, Maule Valle, Chile (50% Syrah, 50% Merlot)

Winemakers Daniella Gillmore and husband Andrés Sánchez produce this red blend from ancient vines of Pais grafted to Syrah and Merlot in the Maule Valley, irrigated only by the winter rains. Aromas of red raspberries and strawberry jam is followed by an elegant dry acidity in the mouth. The wine is fresh, concentrated and well-balanced. Pair with lean meats, and rich stews. **\$18.99/btl**

Symington Altano Douro

2015 Douro Valley, Portugal

Made from a combination of several traditional Douro grape varieties sourced from the Symington family's vineyards. This Altano red has impactful aromas of forest fruit, dark chocolate and mocha, with juicy fruit on the palate underpinned by a racy freshness to fuel and alluringly persistent and spicy finish. Generous, well-structured and elegant. If you love Cabernet Sauvignon – you'll become a fan of Douro! **\$11.99/btl**
