#### **Chateau La Rose du Pin Entre-Deux-Mers    **New Arrival!****

2017 Entre-Deux-Mers, Bordeaux, France (89% Sauvignon Blanc, 11% Semillon)

This exciting yellow-green wine features a notes of lime and boxwood on the nose and a lively attack, balanced with a rounded mid – palate and a lengthy aromatic finish. This wine is fantastic with fish and other seafood.

#### **Ontañón Clarete        **New Arrival!****

2017 Rioja, Spain (75% Viura, 25% Tempranillo)

The Clarete displays a clean, bright and almost transparent coral color. In nose, it expresses a pure, red-fruit component laced with light floral aromas. It is light, crisp and fresh in the mouth, with striking acidity and lifted floral aromas, balanced by delicate red fruit. **\$15.99/btl**

#### **Stangeland Vineyards “Eola Hills Cuvee” Pinot Noir**

2016 Eola Amity Hills, Willamette Valley, Oregon

The Stangeland Vineyard Pinot Noir, crafted by respected winemaker Larry Miller, comes from just north of Salem and is selected from 40 year old vines. Mr. Miller’s minimalist approach is defined by old world techniques, gentle handling of the fruit and aging in French oak. The wine shows impressive structure that hints at its aging potential, while rich red berries, cured tobacco and floral aromas provide immediate satisfaction.

Pair with smoked Trout, game birds and wild mushroom risotto. **\$24.99/btl**

#### **Frecciarossa Uva Rara**

2015 Oltrepo Pavese, Lombardy, Italy (100% Uva Rara)

Uva Rara has a long history of being grown in the Piedmont and Lombardy region where the grape has been historically used as a blending grape, with Nebbiolo in Piedmont and with Barbera and Croatina in Lombardy. It is a bright ruby red color. On the nose it is generous, fruity and persistent with light notes of morello cherry and ripe berries. It is delicate and fragrant. A very well-balanced wine with personality and character from one of our favorite wine regions in Italy! **\$19.99/bottle**

#### **Apaltagua Reserva Carmenere        **New Arrival!****

2017 Valle Central, Chile (100% Carmenere)

Made exclusively with Carmenere, a wine grape (originally from the Medoc region of Bordeaux, France and one of the original six red grapes of Bordeaux) that is now rarely found outside of Chile, this wine shows a spicy, plummy nose and ripe, berry fruit on the palate. Gentle handling of the grapes preserves the quality and character of the fruit for production. This wine is an impressive introduction to the Carmenère grape and a very good value at just **\$13.99/btl**
