Muriel Blanco ***New Arrival!***

2016 Rioja, Spain (85% Viura, 10% Verdejo, 5% Sauvignon Blanc)

This wine is a bright pale yellow color, with greenish reflections. The fruit in the nose and palate are intense and fresh, with floral and fruity notes of white pear, apple and citrus. The palate is juicy and harmoniously acidic leaving a long, fresh and pleasing aftertaste. **\$13.99/btl**

Domaine Gueguen Bourgogne Rosé

2017 Burgundy, France (100% Pinot Noir)

A gorgeous, pale pink in color, this wine was made for sunshine! Aromas of white stone fruits (peach, apricot) and fresh red fruits (strawberries, cranberries) jump out of the glass. On the palate, great minerality and acidity with a round finish of red fruits. So satisfying! Pairs well with just about anything including assorted appetizers, fresh goat cheese, lobster, fruit, and all sorts of BBQ! **\$18.99/btl**

Stephen Ross Pinot Noir

2016 Edna Valley, California

Estate grown in the Stone Corral Vineyard of Edna Valley, classic Burgundian style winemaking, aged in French oak barrels and unfiltered. This wine is an exquisitely clean expression of Pinot Noir fruit. Aromas of Bing cherry pie/compote, cassis, black tea, bittersweet chocolate, cardamom. Medium body with nice berry tannins and long lasting flavors of cherry and plum. The vineyard is Sip Certified and this wine received 91 Points from Wine Enthusiast. **\$29.99/btl**

To Whom Red Blend ***New Arrival!***

2015 North Coast, California

This blend is an elegant expression of a North Coast red. The harmony of dark cherry, vanilla, and raspberry that play off of licorice and chocolate make every sip a delight. This is the kind of wine that we like to settle into and really savor. The flavors are only enhanced by food pairings. To Whom is fantastic with anything incorporating sweet peppers, caramelized onions, and mushrooms. **\$18.99/bottle**

Apaltagua Reserva Carmenere ***New Arrival!***

2017 Valle Central, Chile (100% Carmenere)

Made exclusively with Carmenere, a wine grape (originally from the Medoc region of Bordeaux, France and one of the original six red grapes of Bordeaux) that is now rarely found outside of Chile, this wine shows a spicy, plummy nose and ripe, berry fruit on the palate. Gentle handling of the grapes preserves the quality and character of the fruit for production. This wine is an impressive introduction to the Carmenère grape and a very good value at just **\$13.99/btl**
