

CASA LOS FRAILES MONASTRELL 2011



1771 is the year that the current winemakers' ancestors bought the Estate House Los Frailes. The wine is the most honest expression of their Mediterranean terroir, a unique monastrell from their oldest vines of 85 years old.

1771 is 100% Monastrell grape.

The aging to which the 1771 wine is subjected is 12 months in French oak barrels.

Bright ruby translucent color, the nose screams Monastrell. Violets, tree bark, scorched wet earth and black truffles. In the mouth it's also very typical, with the tell-tale elegant rusticity, an apparent contradiction in terms, but something that you find in the best authentic, unpraised wines in the world, fine tannins and very fresh. So good now, with an even better future. A legend in the making
