**Winery:**

Raised to the status of an appellation Village in 1999, Irancy sits Southwest of Chablis in the northwestern corner of the Burgundy.

The Verret family has been cultivating vines for two and a half centuries. Pioneers among the vineyards of Auxerrois, the Verret family started bottling and direct marketing of their own wines in the 1950s.

At the turn of the millennium, the Verret family made the change to sustainable agriculture and wine making.

**Note:**

95% Pinot Noir and 5% César, specific red wine grape grown in Irancy. Complex and elegant terroirs – Hautes Charmois, Paradis, La Croix Buteix and La Cave.

Kimmeridgian soils, same as Chablis, composed of limestone and clay. S/SW sun exposure.

Aged for 11 months in barrels that are three to eight years old.

A beautiful deep garnet color, a no less intense and elegant nose of red fruits with floral, woody and spicy nuances, and a round and powerful mouth with velvety tannins.
