Whole cluster bladder pressed  
Stainless steel fermented in tank  
Neutral barrel aged for 6 months  
ML inhibited

AVA: Adelaida District; Paso Robles

COMPOSITION: 63% Grenache Blanc, 35% Viognier, 2% Picpoul Blanc

TASTING NOTES: Stony, floral, and tropical tones swirl from nose to palate in this plush, yet elegant West Side Rhone white. Not overly ripe yet offering some proper weight and complexity, this wine shows a seamless expression of Meyer lemon zest, Klondike peach, pineapple, and May blossom with delicate hints of tarragon and musk. Persistent, dazzling acidity supports the exotic nature of the fruit and the brightly layered palate.
