



2019 Domaine Timoine "Les Petites Canailles" Côtes-du-Rhône Organic

Domaine Timoine is the project of Christophe Novara, who oversees the Cellier des Chartreux winery, a cooperative winery, based in the South of France founded 90 years ago. The winemaker is Antoine Gomez. The name "Timoine" is a play on the names of Christophe's children: Tomas, Timothy and Antoine.

Grape Varieties: Syrah 60% Grenache 40% 25 years of age, cropped at 45 hl/ha.

Vineyards: Organically Farmed from commune of Pujaut, adjacent to Tavel

Winemaking: Stainless steel, temperature controlled to extract aroma and freshness.

Maceration on the skins for 20-25 days to extract color and tannin. Pumping over several times during alcoholic fermentation for moderate extraction of color and flavor.

Terroir: Clay and Limestone soil- Argilo-Calcaire in French.

The 2019 Domaine Timoine Cotes-du-Rhone offers a full-bodied, voluptuous and decadent style to go with overflowing notes of plum and darker fruits, licorice and violets. Gorgeous on all counts, it's a shockingly good Côtes du Rhône to drink over the coming 4-6 years. Though it could easily last longer.
